There is no quick and easy solution to the immense and growing educated unemployment in the country. While accelerated growth of the economy and rapid structural; and technological change in the direction of all round industrialization including modernization of agriculture creating many more white-collar jobs somewhat ease the situation, no conceivable rate and pattern of growth can ensure reasonable employment opportunities to the flood that is pouring out of education institutions every year.
